Rank Sum: All the wines were rated on a 100 points scale. The wine with the highest score received rank number 1, wine with the second highest score number 2, The individual rank numbers have been totaled then. The lower the rank sum, the more preferred a wine was over all the tasters. E.g. if you divide the rank sum by the number of tasters, you will receive the average rank (preference) of the wine over all the tasters.
